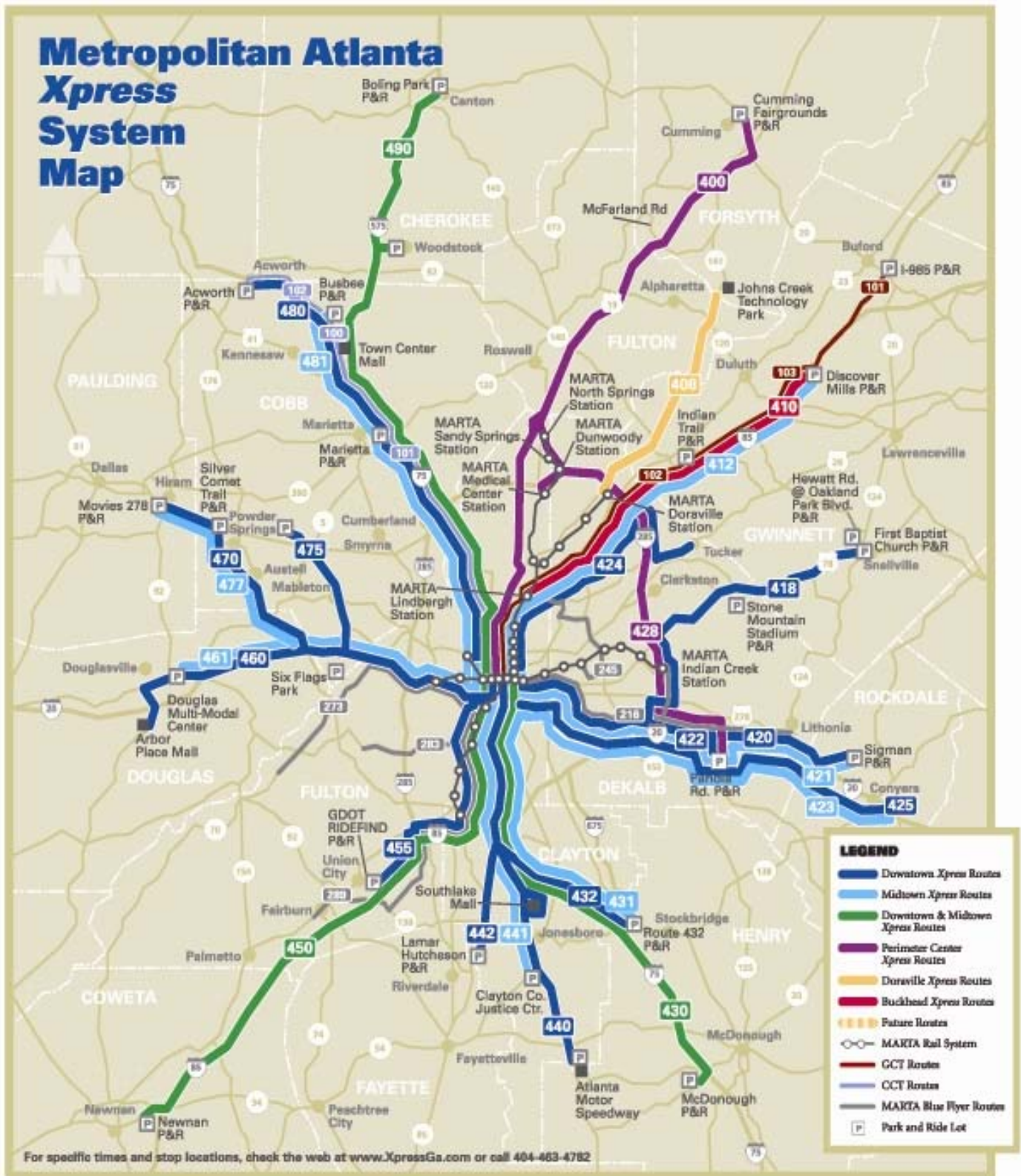


# Metropolitan Atlanta Xpress System Map

### **A note on transfers to and from MARTA:**

Xpress customers may use the Breeze Card on all Xpress coaches managed by the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority (GRTA). The plastic Breeze Card is not required in order to ride the Xpress coaches, but **the plastic Breeze Card or the paper Breeze ticket are required if you want to obtain a free transfer from MARTA bus or rail to the Xpress coach.** You may electronically load a) a GRTA Xpress fare pass, b) a CCT fare pass, c) a MARTA fare pass or d) cash (stored value) to the Breeze regional smart card. You cannot load additional fares on the paper Breeze ticket, but you can tap it to transfer for free.

CCT Bus Operators will not issue a transfer ticket to MARTA. You must use Breeze Media when paying for your fare on a CCT bus or it will not be encoded with a transfer to the MARTA system. You will tap your Breeze Media on the Reader on the MARTA Farebox or Fare gate, and the Breeze system will know you have transferred from CCT to MARTA and allow you to board for free. ~For information on using the Breeze card on Gwinnett County Transit, visit their website: [www.gwinnettcounty.com](http://www.gwinnettcounty.com).

At this time, MARTA is only providing employers participating in its Employer Partnership Program with a monthly paper Breeze ticket. You cannot electronically load a GRTA Xpress fare pass on the Breeze ticket. Check with your Human Resources Department or transit benefits coordinator to see if your employer will provide you with both the MARTA monthly pass and a GRTA Xpress fare pass.
